Our goal is to improve our performance in key measures as compared to other facilities.


LIH Virtual Tour - Entrance



This is the front entrance to the hospital.




This is the front entry, of what we call “The Mall”

Past the west hallway, the patient walks down the mall to the clinics located along the left side of the mall




On the right side of the mall, the patient passes the entrances to Urgent Care and Radiology, Lab, and the Emergency Room

















OEH provides water and sewer services to qualified Native American homeowners.


